Wednesday, June 7, 2023 - Fairbanks Arrival

Thursday, June 8, 2023 - Fairbanks to Denali

Saturday, June 10, 2023 - Denali to Anchorage by Rail

Monday, June 12, 2023 - Scenic cruising Hubbard Glacier

Enjoy the majesty of Hubbard Glacier today from the ship! Hubbard Glacier is the largest tidewater glacier in North America and nicknamed the "Galloping Glacier." The area around Hubbard Glacier is renowned for its wildlife, where whales, harbor seals and otters swim, brown bears, moose and black-tailed deer roam ashore, and a wide variety of seabirds soar gracefully across the sky.



Tuesday, June 13, 2023 - Glacier Bay National Park

Cruise the ice-studded fjords of this national treasure for a full eight hours as a Park Service Ranger narrates. Frosted peaks towering over mossy forests, wide tidewater glaciers (there are seven in the park), and marine wildlife are givens on Glacier Bay cruises, but every experience is unique.

Wednesday, June 14, 2023 - Skagway

Step back to the days of the last great gold rush-choose from exciting shore excursions and still have time to shop. At the height of the Klondike Gold Rush, the port town of Skagway served as the primary gateway to the legendary gold fields, and quickly grew into Alaska's largest settlement.

Thursday, June 15, 2023 - Juneau

Enjoy a full day of exploring Alaska's capital-choose from exciting shore excursions and still have time to shop. Juneau is the most remote, most beautiful, and strangest state capital in the United States. Surrounded by water, forest and mountain sights, visitors can hike a glacier, go whale watching, and eat fresh-caught fish on a seaside patio all in one day.

Friday, June 16, 2023 - Ketchikan

Explore this uniquely Alaskan port, famous for its rich native culture, salmon fishing, and scenic Misty Fjords. Alaska's "First City" of Ketchikan is so named because it's the first major landfall for most cruisers as they enter the picturesque fjords of the Inside Passage, where the town clings to the banks of the Tongass Narrows, flanked by green forests nurtured by abundant rain.

Saturday, June 17, 2023 - Scenic cruising The Inside Passage

Relax and enjoy a full day of scenic Inside Passage cruising and immerse yourself in Holland America Line elegance. Alaska's Inside Passage is a protected network of waterways that wind through glacier-cut fjords and lush temperate rain forests along the rugged coast of Southeast Alaska.

You will have opportunities to spot some of Alaska's most iconic wildlife, with humpback whales and orca plying the bountiful waters alongside the ships, bald eagles soaring overhead and brown bears lumbering on the shoreline.

Sunday, June 18, 2023 - Vancouver, Disembark the ship, back to reality....
