Tour Stinerary:

Day 1/North Dakota to Roseville, MN

We begin our *"Country Music Adventure"* as our journey begins today from Bismarck, North Dakota. Tonight, we stop in Roseville, MN for our welcome dinner and overnight. (D)

Day 2/Roseville, MN to Bloomington, IL

Day 3/Bloomington to Horns Lake, MS

This evening we are off to the **Dixie Stampede** to enjoy a wonderful show and dinner. (CB, D)
