

Detailed Itinerary:

Day 2, August 25, 2020: ARRIVE IN MUNICH, GERMANY

Welcome to Munich! At 6 pm, meet your Tour Director and traveling companions for a welcome dinner at your hotel. (D)

Day 3, August 26, 2020: MUNICH-PRAGUE, CZECH REPUBLIC

Germany's "Secret Capital" comes alive during an orientation featuring the <u>Olympic Stadium</u>, 1,000-foot-high Olympic Tower, and <u>MARIENPLATZ</u>, in the historic heart of the city. Later, head for the Czech border in the Bohemian Forest and travel to <u>Prague</u>, the "Golden City." This evening, why not join an optional outing to explore Prague by night? (B, D)

Day 4:, August 27, 2020: PRAGUE

Morning sightseeing with a Local Guide reveals why Prague is considered one of Europe's most attractive capitals. Visit the 1,000-year-old <u>HRADANY CASTLE GROUNDS</u>. Also, see St. Vitus Cathedral, the Old Town, the Jewish ghetto, and the <u>ASTRONOMICAL CLOCK</u>, once the envy of all Europe. Exciting optional excursions are available to make the most of your stay. (B)

Day 5, August 28, 2020: PRAGUE-BRATISLAVA, SLOVAKIA-BUDAPEST, HUNGARY

Into Moravia, where Napoleon established his headquarters during the Battle of Austerlitz and arrive in Bratislava, capital of Slovakia, for an orientation of this town. Then, follow the course of the Danube River to Budapest. (B, D)

Day 6, August 29, 2020: BUDAPEST

Your Local Guide takes you through Eastern Europe's most cosmopolitan city. See elegant <u>Andrassy Avenue</u>, the <u>Thermal Baths</u>, and the world's second-largest Jewish synagogue. From the lacy lookout towers of <u>Fishermen's Bastion</u>, enjoy a panoramic view of the sprawling city. Then, visit the 13th-century <u>MATTHIAS</u> <u>CORONATION CHURCH</u> and <u>Heroes' Square</u>. Afternoon at leisure. Tonight, a delectable optional <u>Hungarian specialty dinner</u> can be arranged. (B)

Day 7, August 30, 2020: BUDAPEST-VIENNA, AUSTRIA

This morning, drive through the Hungarian plains to Vienna, once the center of the mighty <u>Habsburg Empire</u>. Meet your Local Guide and start your afternoon sightseeing with a drive along the elegant <u>Ringstrasse</u>. Pass the impressive <u>State Opera House</u>, the <u>Jewish quarter</u>, and stop at the <u>Hofburg Palace</u>, winter residence of the Austrian imperial family. Marvel at the impressive courtyards and famous <u>Heldenplatz</u>, and visit awesome <u>ST. STEPHEN'S CATHEDRAL</u>. (B)

Day 8, August 31, 2020: AT LEISURE IN VIENNA

Today is your chance to join exciting optional excursions, such as to the <u>Vienna Woods</u>, historic <u>Schönbrunn</u> <u>Palace</u>, a concert in one of <u>Vienna's concert halls</u>, or to just explore this magnificent city on your own. (B)

Day 9, September 1, 2020: VIENNA-SALZBURG

Enjoy a leisurely DANUBE CRUISE along the most scenic section of the river and have <u>Kaffee und Kuchen</u> (coffee and cake). Then, drive through the lovely <u>Salzkammergut Lakeland</u> to picturesque Salzburg. On arrival, meet your Local Guide for a walking tour through the historical center. Admire <u>MIRABELL</u> <u>GARDENS</u>, the Great Festival Hall, <u>St. Peter's Monastery</u>, and magnificent <u>RESIDENZ SQUARE</u>, where some scenes of the Sound of Music movie were filmed, and take pictures of <u>Mozart's Birthplace</u> in the charming <u>Getreidegasse</u>. A special dinner at St. Peter Stiftskeller awaits you. (B, D)

This morning, you may wish to join the optional excursion to Berchtesgaden before continuing to picturesque Oberammergau. (B, D)

Day 11, September 3, 2020: OBERAMMERGAU

The afternoon and evening are dedicated to the world-famous <u>PASSION PLAY</u>, held every 10 years and performed by the people of Oberammergau. (B, D)

Day 12, September 4, 2020: OBERAMMERGAU-MUNICH

Return to Munich. The best way to say auf Wiedersehen is with a visit to the famous <u>HOFBRÄUHAUS</u>, Munich's best-known beer hall, dating back to 1589, followed by a farewell dinner at the hotel. (B,D)



Day 13, September 5, 2020: MUNICH

This morning we say farewell to this magnificent area and travel home with many amazing memories! (B)
