# Detailed Folklorama Itinerary

**Monday, August 10, 2020:** We depart Bismarck this morning traveling to Minot than onto Manitoba. We will be staying at the Canad Inns Club Regent Resort and Casino. A group **dinner** will be included this evening at Mon Ami Louis, one of Winnipeg's most unique restaurants. (D)

**Tuesday, August 11, 2020:** We start our day off with a **Hot Breakfast Buffet** at the hotel. After breakfast we depart on a **City Tour of Winnipeg**.
